AEROSPACE ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS 2006

The American Helicopter Society, Australian Chapter was established in July 2003 with the election of Office bearers and opening of its Chapter Bank Account. During the chapters meeting in July 2003, it was decided to pioneer a scholarship grant to students pursuing Doctoral Research in the area of Helicopter Design. Two scholarships of AUD\$2500 each are to be awarded for the year 2006.

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must

- Be a full-time PhD by research student at an accredited school of aerospace engineering in Australia.
- The research area of the student should be in helicopter design.
- The applicant should be a student member of the AHS.
- Complete the entire Application for Scholarship (Sections I, II, III and IV).
