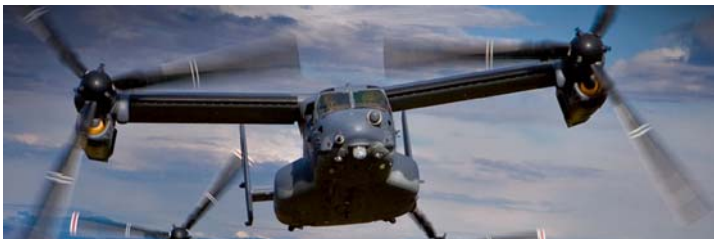

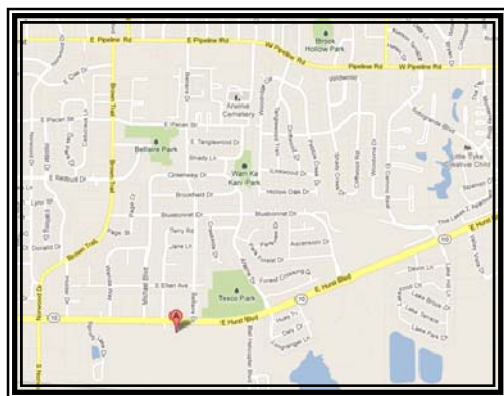
## John Garrison, CEO, Bell Helicopter Textron Attracting Top Talent into the Aerospace Engineering Career Field Tuesday, February 19, 2013
