TRANSFORMATIVE VERTICAL FLIGHT (TVF) 2025 EXHIBIT RULES

Exhibit / Exhibit Space

For the purpose of this agreement, the term "exhibit" or "exhibit space" refers to an in-person exhibit display.

Exhibitor Eligibility

Products and services displayed at TVF 2025 must be associated with the vertical flight, aviation and/or aerospace technology industries. VFS reserves the right to reject an exhibit application or remove an exhibitor's display if a company's product/service does not meet this requirement.

Exhibit Space Package

Exhibit space is sold in 10'x10' units. Linear booths are separated by standard pipe and drape and will be provided a standard booth ID sign. A 6-ft skirted table, two side chairs, wastepaper basket, booth carpet and a 500W electrical outlet are also included with each 10'x10 space. The exhibit space package does NOT include any Material or Drayage costs, which must be ordered directly from the convention center service vendor.

Exhibitors will be provided with one (1) complementary attendee registration for each 10'x10' exhibit space. A meeting registration provides full access to all events as well as food and beverage activities. There are no exhibit hall or visitor badges: all attendees must register to attend and will receive full access to the exhibit hall and all meeting events.

Exhibitors should submit their company logo to the Vertical Flight Society for publishing on the TVF 2025 event page and final program agenda.

Subleasing or Sharing Exhibit Space

Exhibitor may not sublet or share exhibit space, nor display, advertise articles not manufactured or sold by the exhibiting company, except where such articles are necessary for proper demonstration or operation of the exhibitor's display.

Use of Exhibit Space

All exhibitor activities must be confined to the limits of an exhibitor's allocated exhibit space and must not interfere with the activity of other exhibitors. All exhibits shall serve the interest of VFS members and TVF 2025 attendees and shall be always operated in a professional and dignified manner. Exhibitors must comply with all exhibit hall set-up and dismantling rules as stated in the TVF 2025 Exhibitor Service Kit. Exhibitors may not dismantle or disturb their exhibits until after the event's official closing time.

Union Labor

Exhibitors are required to observe all union contracts in effect among show management, official contractors, facilities and various labor organizations represented. Any required labor for installation or dismantle, decoration or use of equipment must be ordered through the official service contractor. Exhibitors must comply with all rules pertaining to exhibit hall access and the material handling of booth freight and associated materials.

Exhibitor Giveaways, Lotteries and Contests

Exhibitors conducting a contest or drawing of any kind must follow all governmental laws, ordinances, rules and regulations. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure they correctly follow all rules and regulations. Any violations will be at the sole expense and fault of the exhibitor. VFS is not responsible or liable for any contests, drawings or giveaways held prior, during or after the meeting.

VFS logos

The VFS logo is the property of VFS and may not be used without receiving approval from the Vertical Flight Society. An exhibitor shall not in any manner indicate that VFS approves or endorses its products or services without written consent from VFS.

Licenses and Permits

Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any licenses, permits or approvals required under local or state law applicable to exhibit space. An exhibitor shall be responsible for paying all associated taxes, license fees or other charges that shall become due to any government authority in connection with their exhibit.

Liability Insurance

The exhibitor acknowledges that neither the VFS nor any of the Indemnities maintain insurance covering exhibitors' property, nor is VFS responsible for obtaining insurance covering such property and any loss or damage incurred by an exhibitor. Upon signing the Application for Exhibit Space and Contract, the exhibiting firm is asked to provide the VFS with a certificate of insurance (COI) or an affidavit that carries a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 in general liability insurance applicable to its exhibitor participation at TVF 2025. A completed COI form may be mailed to VFS or submitted to exhibits@vtol.org.

No-Show Policy

An exhibiting company will be considered a no-show if its exhibit space is not prepared in time for the opening of the event. If such a situation occurs, an exhibitor shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the event and will forfeit its exhibit space payment.

Hold Harmless – Indemnification

Exhibitor acknowledges that VFS is not liable for any and all claims, demands or damages of any kind arising from its exhibit display at TVF 2025.

Force Majeure

It is mutually agreed that if TVF 2025 is cancelled in whole or in part, or its scheduled opening is cancelled or delayed, due to fire, explosion, strike, freight embargo, act of God, act of public enemy, act of war, war, act of terrorism, civil disturbance, act of any government, de jure or de facto, or other government declaration or regulation, epidemic or other event over which VFS has no control, then the exhibitor contract may be immediately amended by VFS, and an exhibitor hereby waives any and all claims against the VFS for damages, reimbursement, refund, or compensation. VFS shall not be financially liable in the event the show is interrupted, cancelled, moved or rescheduled.

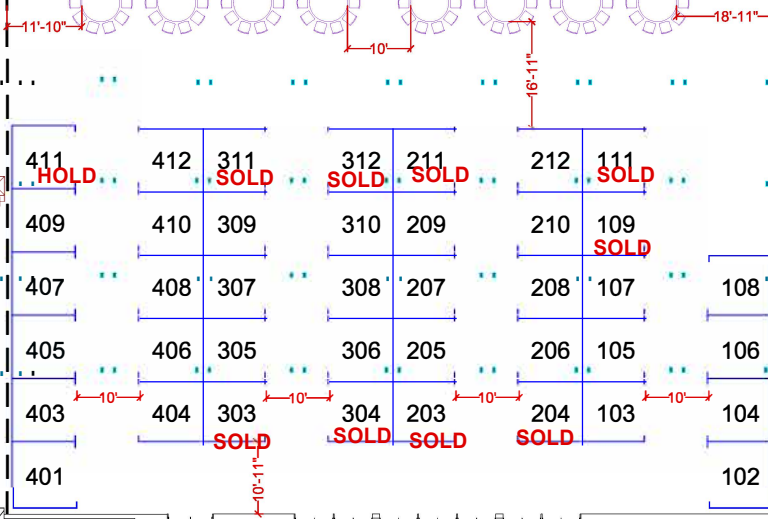
Agreement and Amendments to Exhibit Rules

Exhibit rules and regulations may be amended or changed at any time by the Vertical Flight Society and all amendments and changes will be binding on all parties. Any violation of the TVF 2025 Exhibit Rules shall constitute a breach of this contract. Remedy to any breach includes, but is not limited to, termination of any and all rights to the exhibit space and the forfeiture of any fees paid.
