Captain Wykoff, an active pilot for Delta Air Lines, held numerous leadership positions in his home association, the Air Line Pilots Association, International (ALPA) including Executive Administrator and negotiating committee chairman for the Delta Master Executive Council (MEC).

As current chairman of the ALPA Flight Time/Duty Time Committee, he is responsible for the development of scheduling guidelines and best practices for the mitigation of fatigue among pilots. He recently served as co-chair of the United States Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Aviation Rulemaking Committee (ARC) charged with overhauling FAA flight and duty regulations.

He graduated from the University of Cincinnati with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree, majoring in finance. He retired as a US Air Force fighter pilot. Captain Wykoff resides in Cincinnati, Ohio with his wife Susan.
