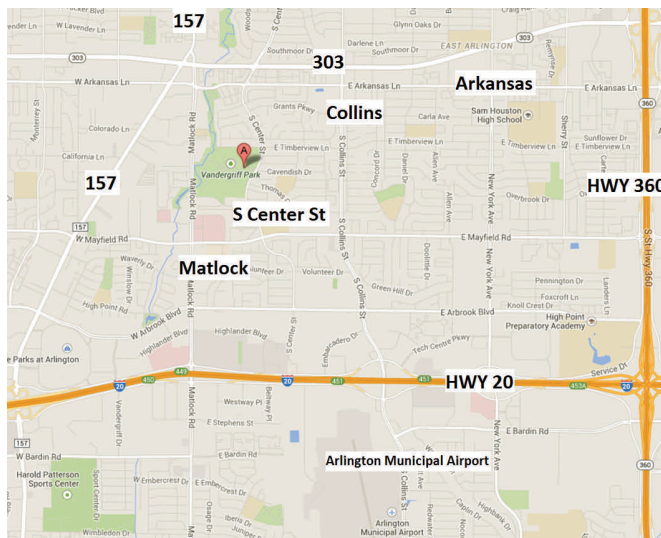
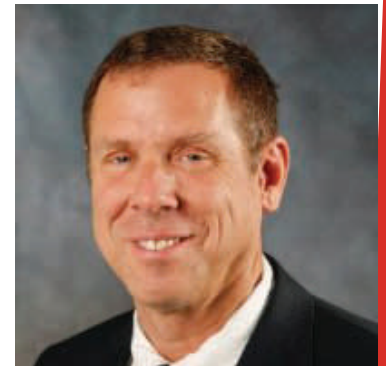
Dan Wells

Flight Test Pilot, AgustaWestland

From 16,000 lb Glider to Autorotating Tiltrotor in 12 Seconds

Thursday, March 19, 2015

Dan Wells was a career U.S. Army pilot and test pilot. In 1994 he attended U.S. Naval Test Pilot School at Patuxent River, Maryland and subsequently served at the U.S. Army Aviation Technical Test Center at Fort Rucker, Alabama. He returned to Test Pilot School as an instructor where he served for six years. In 2006, the Army assigned him to the U.S. Air Force where he served at Edwards AFB, California as a test pilot on the CV-22 program. In 2008, he retired from the Army and went to work for Boeing flying the C-130 Avionics Modernization Program and then the MH-47G Digital Automatic Flight Control System tests. In 2011, he came to Bell Helicopter where he flew on the BA609 and the 412EPi, and in 2013, he moved over to AgustaWestland in order to remain on the AW609.
